“Hello, Dear Enemy!” Picture Books for Peace and Humanity

Travelling exhibition

In 1998, the travelling exhibition **“Hello, Dear Enemy!”** (orig. „**Guten Tag, lieber Feind!**“) went on its first journey. In the following years, the exhibit was revised in regular intervals and presented by numerous libraries, schools, Goethe-Institutes and other cultural institutions in Germany and abroad (for example in Italy, Croatia, India, Japan, Korea, Russia, USA).

In 2014, the exhibition was extensively revised for its first presentation in the International Youth Library. Since then, the exhibits (44 posters and 70 books unless described otherwise) have travelled to the following venues so far:
